THE BACK BUTTON

Once the user has arrived at any list of specials, please direct them to select one of the specials.

Q1: Does it feel like anything is missing from this page?

Q2: Can you please go back to that list of dining specials again?

The user may have returned to the Dine page, but if they did not return to the Dine page, ask them to go there now. You may need to ask them to scroll down until they can see the specials.
